

## CRANE Database: Question and Answer (Q&A) Session 23 February 2026

### 1. What was the purpose of this session?

The annual Q&A session brought together cleft services from across the UK to:



Clarify data requirements for the 2026 Annual Report and SSQD dashboards



Answer service-led questions about data entry, submissions and governance



Share updates on the database, consent forms, and new clinical fields



Support teams in preparing for national reporting deadlines

### 2. Attendees

The meeting was facilitated by Dr Kate Fitzsimons, Senior Research Fellow for CRANE and Samriddhi Sharma, Project Coordinator for CRANE. It was attended by a total of 30 representatives from different specialities within almost all regional cleft services, as well as 3 CRANE team members.

### 3. Key updates to the CRANE Database

#### Organisational Audit Report 2025

- [Published](#) July 2025 with 100% response from services
- Highlights workforce pressures, variation in access, and high engagement with CRANE

#### Annual Report 2025

- [Published](#) December 2025
- Included registry data, outcomes, audit findings, infographic and outlier responses

#### Updated family information leaflets & consent forms

- Redesigned with CLAPA, CNS teams and patient representatives
- Clearer, shorter, and country-specific (England/Wales, NI, Scotland)
- Reflect each nation's legal bases for data handling

#### Gestational age & birthweight

- The data items now required for all registrations (including non-consented cases) from 2026 onwards
- Gestational age includes "+days"
- Data items may move to 'Patient Details'. Will communicate if/when this happens.
- This change is due to Section 251 approval

#### 5-year-old index

- Now open to complete BCLP cases (LAHSAL)
- Retrospective entry encouraged. Imports can facilitate this.

#### Psychology outcomes at 10 years

- Cleft Q & TIM fields (Psychological & Social Functioning)
- Expected to go live in May 2026

### 4. Data submission deadlines

#### [Data Collection Milestones 2026](#)

##### Annual Report- June 2026

- Submit updates by 28 June 2026
- Extract on 29 June 2026
- Required:
  - Registrations for 2023–2025 births
  - 5-year outcomes for 2017–2019 births with consent
- Outlier letters in August; responses due end of September



## Dashboards ([SSQD](#))

- 13 March 2026- Q3 indicator (CLP00-CLP02)
- 19 June 2026- Q4 indicator (CLP00-CLP02, CLP05, CLP06, CLP09)

## 5. Data issues to address

Teams should review and update:

- Missing postcode and sex
- Missing LAHSAL
- Missing SMCP (No/Yes) and Simonart's (Not present/Yes)
- Missing syndrome coding (No/Yes)
- Incomplete dental and speech data
- Always complete VP surgery and fistula repair fields (No/Yes)
- Transfers - if transferring to another centre, do so well ahead of data extract data (>1 month)
- Consent not yet verified for 2017-2019 births

## 6. How to check and update data

### Database access

- New access process introduced in February 2025
- Existing users can request access for colleagues
- Clinical Lead approves all requests

### Live tables

Use the below to review missing data and consent rates:

- Consent tables (2017-2019 & 2023-2025 births)
- Outcomes table (2017-2019)
- Identifier table (NHS #, postcode, sex)

### Imports

- Imports overwrite existing data- always export first
- Useful for:
  - 5-year outcomes
  - 5-year old index scores for retrospective complete BCLP cases
  - Psychology outcomes (later in 2026)

### Timeliness and Reminders

- Submit data using imports at least 1 week prior to deadlines in case of errors
- Ensure transfers are completed early
- Prioritise verifying consent for 2017-2019 births

## 8. Information governance and actions

Information governance

- Use CRANE ID only when contacting CRANE
- Do not send any identifiable data by email or the website form
- CRANE follows UK GDPR, DPA 2018, and CAG/Section 251 governance

Actions for services

- Review identifiers and missing fields regularly
- Keep local forms aligned with the latest data dictionary
- Export before importing so existing data is not overwritten
- Process transfers promptly
- Use QI tools to maintain data completeness

## 9. Recommendations to units (based on 2025 data)

- Collaborate with maternity services to improve antenatal diagnosis rates (Cleft Net East)
- Improve diagnosis within 72 hours for CPO (Newcastle, Spires, Trent, North Thames)
- Improve antenatal CNS contact within 24 hours (West Midlands, South West, Newcastle, North Thames)
- Review low positive consent rates (Newcastle)
- Improve dmft submissions (North Thames, West Midlands, Trent, Evelina)
- Improve 5-year-old index submissions to have sufficient number for funnel plot (West Midland, Northern Ireland)
- Address psychology capacity issues (Northern Ireland, West Midlands, Liverpool, North Thames)
